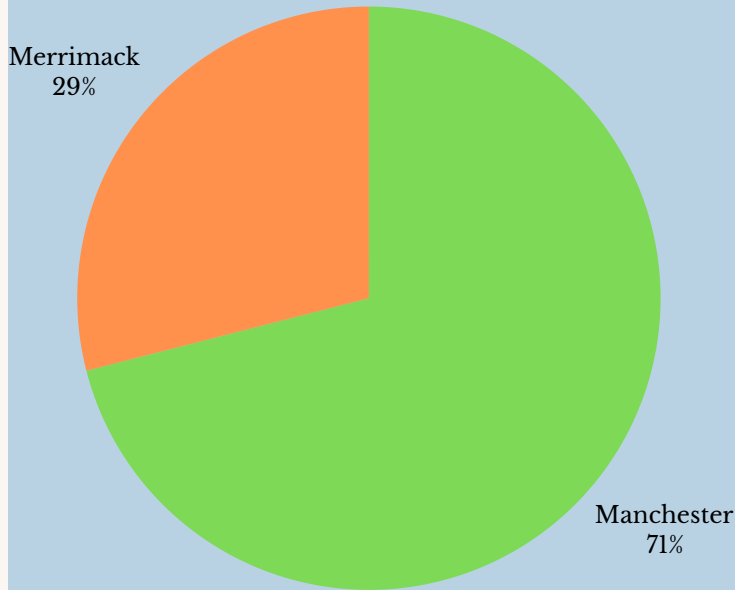

2024 by the numbers

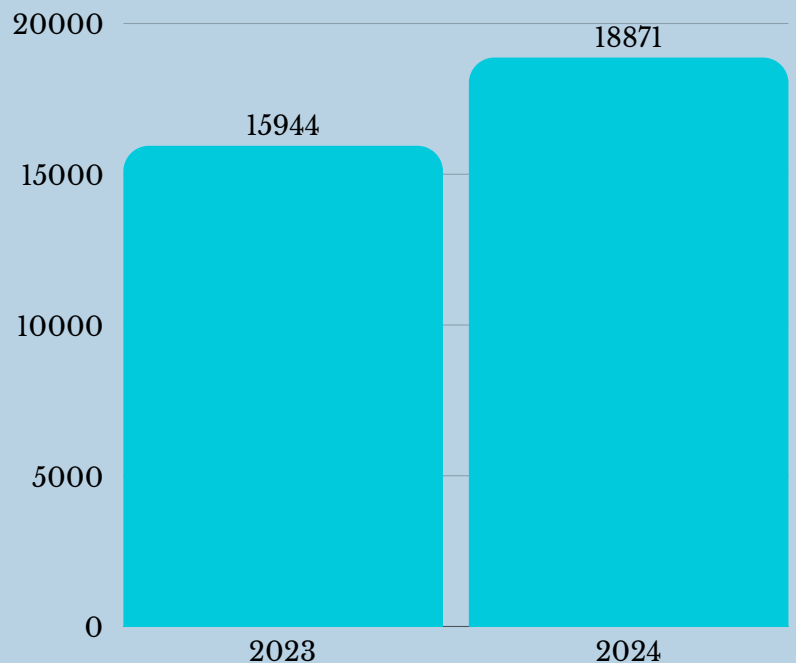


A total of 18,871 individual acupuncture treatments given in 2024

MAS performed almost 20% more treatments in 2024 vs 2023.

2024 into 2025

In addition to a growing Home-Visit Program, MAS also launched the 5NP Ear Acupuncture Training Program teaming with HOPE for Recovery and POCA. 5NP is a well-known recipe of five ear points that helps address physical and emotional symptoms related to toxic stress, drug and alcohol detox, chronic pain, anxiety, PTSD, depression, trauma, shock and addiction recovery.

Plans for trainings will extend into 2025 and beyond.
