Closing only to offer staff well-earned time off this past year, MAS increased treatment numbers by 50% over 2020.

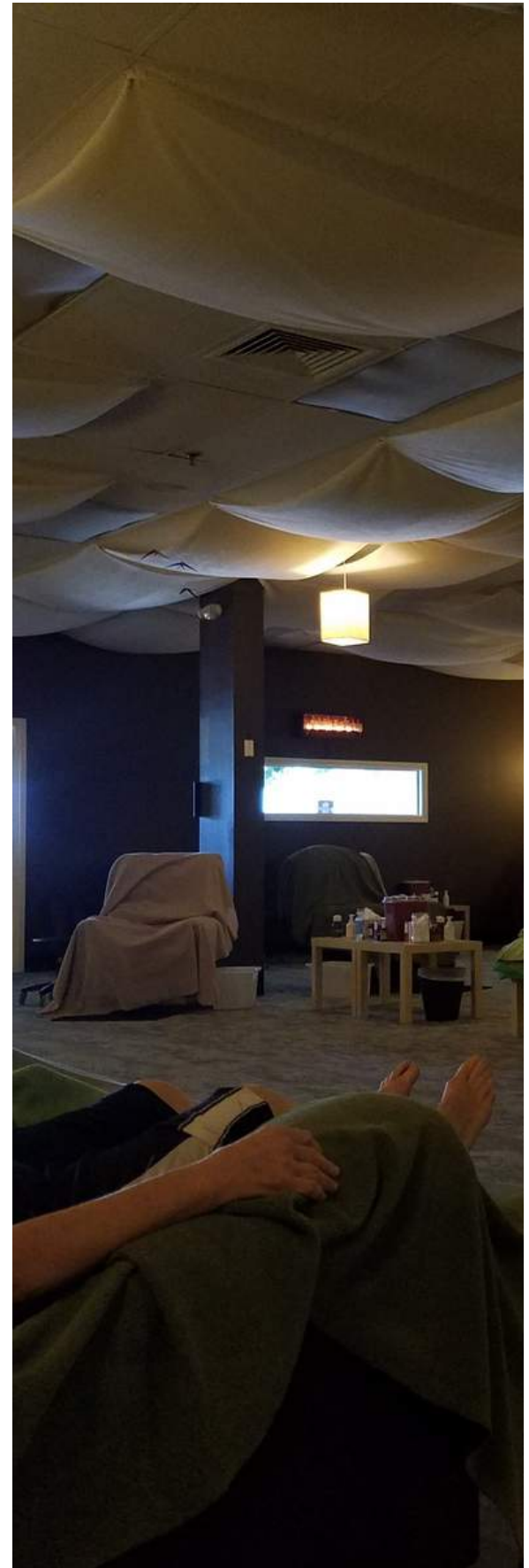
The organization was also able to develop new working relationships with key local businesses and non-profits in 2021 to help ensure mutual stability moving forward.
